A new project examines the green energy transition in the north. He is the editor of *Urban Sustainability in the Arctic: Measuring Progress in Circumpolar Cities* (NY: Berghahn, 2020). He has published extensively on Arctic topics and issues related to the development of Ukraine and Russia's political systems. Orttung received a B.A. in Russian Studies from Stanford University and both a M.A. and Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of California, Los Angeles.
