

Kelly Moan serves as the Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) for the New York Police Department (NYPD). In this role, Ms. Moan leads the Information Security team to protect, defend, and strengthen the security posture of the NYPD against cyber threats. Throughout her career, Ms. Moan has taken a holistic and mission driven approach to cybersecurity.

Prior to joining the NYPD, Ms. Moan was the Division Chief of Enterprise Engineering for the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) in Washington, DC.
