

Donald Saxinger is the Section Chief for IT Supervision in the FDIC's Operational Risk Group. His unit is responsible for coordinating the FDIC's nation-wide IT/cyber examination program at service providers and large banks, identifying risk trends, and overseeing program direction to ensure that emerging risks are addressed. The FDIC conducts on-site IT examinations at thousands of financial institutions and over 200 technology service providers to evaluate risk management processes for IT, cyber, operational risk, and resiliency to ensure the safety and soundness of financial institutions, sector resiliency, and protection of consumer data. Mr. Saxinger joined the FDIC in 1991 and has served in numerous roles including safety and soundness

examiner, IT examiner, case manager, Chair of the FFIEC Cybersecurity and Critical Infrastructure Working Group, and Chair of the FFIEC IT Examination Handbook Working Group.
