In Ms. Maxey's role as a development Agile Team Lead, she is responsible for several Agile development teams developing mission critical applications for one of DHS' Acquisition Level 1 Program's, with a lifecycle cost of over \$1 billion. This system is responsible for overseeing the delivery and sustainment of technology solutions that support the security and legitimacy of the international supply chain, fosters U.S. economic competitiveness, intercepts threats at the border, and expedites the movement of safe and legitimate cargo. Ms. Maxey is also the lead and Technology Modernization Fund (TMF) liaison for the first DHS TMF proposal and eventual TMF award of \$15 million. This proposal to the TMF encompassed over two years of extensive and detailed collaboration, and the funding received for this modernization effort not only drives operational efficiency and decreases software and maintenance expenditures at DHS, but it will also have a direct positive impact on U.S. businesses, partnering government agencies and countries.



Ms. Maxey has worked for CBP as a contractor and federal government public servant for over 16 years. She holds a bachelor's degree in Homeland Security with a minor in Emergency Planning and Management and an Associate's degree in Counterterrorism studies.
