

Colleen Heller-Stein is the Director, Office of Human Resources and Deputy Chief Human Capital Officer at the Department of the Treasury, with responsibilities for providing leadership in developing, directing and evaluating human resources policies and programs supporting Departmental Offices, as well as providing support to Treasury's bureaus, particularly through her leadership of Treasury's Learning Leaders Council.

Colleen began her service with Treasury as the HR Business Partner for Domestic Finance in 2010, where she led or supported the stand up of several new offices, including TARP's compliance team, the CFPB and the Financial Stability Oversight Council. Following a 10 month engagement with the Securities and Exchange Commission in 2015 as the Senior Advisor to the Chief Human Capital Officer, Colleen returned to Treasury in 2016 to serve the role of Director, Office of Human Resources. Colleen gained additional Treasury-wide responsibilities upon initial appointment to the Senior Executive Service as Deputy Chief Human Capital Officer in November, 2019 and after serving as Acting Chief Human Capital Officer from January 2021-August 2022.

Before joining the Treasury Department Colleen held numerous positions in state and Federal government with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, U.S. Government Publishing Office, and the Department of Veterans Affairs, where she worked abroad supporting active duty military personnel and veterans in Germany, Belgium, and the Netherlands.

Born and raised in and around the great city of Philadelphia, Colleen is a first generation college graduate who holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in American Studies from Dickinson College and a Master of Public Administration degree from the George Washington University's Trachtenberg School of Public Policy and Public Administration.
